The Internship program builds your capacity for future leadership opportunities within CCO. Upon successful completion of the one year internship, Campus Interns take on the role of Campus Missionary, who are responsible for proclaiming Jesus clearly and simply, leading and forming students through CCO's approach to discipleship, and preparing students to be leaders in the renewal of the world upon graduation.

- Plan large group outreach and social events
- Work in close collaboration with a team of Campus Missionaries to build a multiplying movement
- Participate in CCO's Internship Training program
